# PRINCIPAL REPORT TO SCHOOL COUNCIL NOVEMBER 3, 2021

**CONCUSSION AWARENESS TRAINING-** As mandated by the Ministry, all staff (office, EAs, ECEs, lunch monitors, administration, library technicians, custodial) will receive their one hour of training to ensure everyone is aware of the signs and symptoms of concussion. This training is to be completed by all staff by November 30th. Any student who may have hit their head at any point in the day is sent to the office for assessment and the concussion protocol is followed right away. The office will also reach out to families to keep you updated if a child is ever in the office for potential concussion follow-up.

PROGRESS REPORTS/PARENT TEACHER INTERVIEWS- At Jockvale, the month of November signals a period of reflection as it marks the first reporting period of the 2021-2022 school year. It is the perfect time for parents and guardians to receive a formal update of 'how things are progressing'. The goal of this interim report card is to provide an opportunity to identify both the student's strengths and areas for improvement early in the school year. It provides parents with a snapshot of their child's progress. Progress Reports will be emailed home to parents/guardians the evening of November 4th and will be followed by a parent/teacher interview on the evening of November 10th or the morning of November 12th. More details to follow regarding how to sign up for an interview.

**UPCOMING PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITY DAY**- A reminder that there will be a PA Day for all elementary students on Friday, November 12th. Elementary staff will be engaged in virtual parent/teacher interviews.

**LIBRARY DONATION-** Thank you to a Jockvale family for their generous donation of \$500 towards our Library to augment our LGBTQ2+ resources. Happy reading, Jags!

**SAIDAT-** As part of our introduction of Bullying Awareness and Prevention Week activities, Saidat will join our Junior students virtually on November 9th and take them on a journey to build a kind, respectful, and socially responsible classroom. Some of the critical topics to be covered include: PERSPECTIVE, IDENTITY, DIVERSITY and STEREOTYPES. Her goal is to reduce bullying through building respect and social responsibility.

Students from JK to Grade 3 will receive a pre-recorded 10-day video series that will include follow-up activities after each episode. These videos focus on



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- Creating a Friendly, Kind, and Helpful Classroom
- Amplifying the Importance of Learning
- Developing Well-Being
- Building a Socially Responsible Classroom
- Discussing Diversity and Inclusion

**LUV 2 GROOVE-** This year, Jockvale will be participating in the virtual LUV 2 GROOVE Dance program. We have purchased the instructional videos (5 per grade division) so that our Jaguars will have the opportunity to move and groove with Miss Julia, Miss Amanda and Mr. Xander as part of the Dance curriculum. Students will learn the elements of dance (body, space, time, etc.) through movement activities and dance routines. We thank the Woodvale Pentacostal Church for their generous donation of \$1000 towards this program.

#### **BETTY THE SERVICE ANIMAL**

Betty's training resumed at Jockvale on Tuesday, November 2nd. Students have written Betty welcome letters and drawn her pictures. We will read <u>Harley the Hero</u> as a school in honour of Betty's work at Jockvale.

### **EMBRACING INDIGENEITY AT JOCKVALE**

As a staff, we continue to follow the District's Equity Road Map and work on developing and sharing our understandings of Indigeneity at Jockvale. #### A (NOT SO) UNEXPECTED VISITOR


