OCDSB graduates go to university, college, apprenticeship, work, community living

List of characteristics: resilient, adaptable, globally aware, collaborative, innovative & creative

List of skills: critical thinkers, effective communicators, academically diverse, digital fluency

note diversity of high schools (e.g., adult education)

This draft document spells out why each of the characteristics and skills is important and how OCDSB will develop it. E.g., "We will develop resiliency in our students by having high, achievable expectations for their learning, and supporting, quiding and nurturing them through the learning process."
