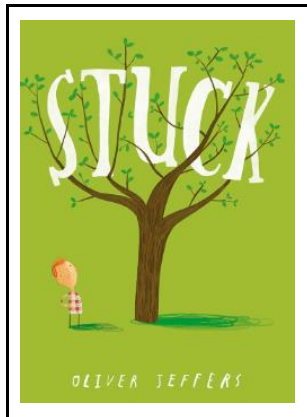
Coffee & Tea Fundraiser -
