Beginning on April 3rd, 2024, Jockvale will use the Safe Arrival System which is an automated attendance program. The Safe Arrival System will replace some of our current attendance routines. We will send out a specific message with information and instructions next week. Here is some information about our new system:

What is SafeArrival?

SafeArrival is a new system for managing student absences. Families can report absences in advance using a mobile app, website, or toll-free phone line. These options are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Why is the OCDSB using SafeArrival?


- Enhances student safety.
