

THE CATERPILLARS (KJSC) EXPLORE COLOUR







This week the Caterpillars class learned about primary (blue, red, yellow) and secondary (green, orange, purple) colours. The children had the opportunity to participate in a colour experiment to learn how to create secondary colours. All the children were able to share their predictions, or guesses, about what happens when you mix 2 primary colours together, and they were thrilled to see the outcome of the experiment! They then had the chance to conduct their own personal experiment through painting to see if they could create secondary colours by mixing primary colours together. They also enjoyed mixing all primary and secondary colours together to see what new colours they could create! Many students were surprised that mixing all the colours together made different shades of brown!


To conduct the experiment at home, you need water, milk and food colouring (red, blue and yellow). Fill 3 cups with half water and a little milk. The three combinations for mixing are: (1) red + blue = purple, (2) red + yellow = orange, and (3) blue + yellow = green. Try changing the amount of food colouring you use to see how the secondary colours change (i.e., are they light or dark coloured).
