


When: Tuesday May 7th, 6:30pm (Doors open at 6:00pm)

This year Ms. Baines Grade 5's have been using Canva to create All About Me posters to share with a class in China as well as a collective class collage of all things that represent Canada.



This assessment is a standardized test written by all students in grades 3 and 6 across the province of Ontario. The assessment measures student achievement in Reading, Writing, and Mathematics.
