
## **JOCKVALE'S FRIDAY MESSAGE - OCT. 27th, 2023**



SKIING FOR JUNIOR STUDENTS @ MOUNT PAKENHAM - We are thrilled to be planning Ski/Snowboard Days at Mount Pakenham for the first time since Covid! We already have 30 junior students who are planning to participate!

This trip is being offered to our Grades 4, 5, and 6 students as part of our physical education program and is a great opportunity for your child to begin, or continue, their skiing/snowboarding experience.

The four dates that we are tentatively looking at are Thursdays January 18th, 25th, February 1st & 8th. You may select any number of days to participate.

Students will be bussed to and from Jockvale to Mount Pakenham (about 45 mins away). Students are able to rent equipment or bring their own. All students will receive a one hour lesson each day of the trip, regardless of their previous ability. We estimate leaving the school at 9 am and returning around 5 pm. Students will need to be picked up from school when the bus returns.

All ability levels are welcome, from beginner to advanced! Pakenham has a wide variety of hills and students must be able to pass various levels of tests in order to even get on the chair lift. We recommend students who are new to snow sports choose skiing instead of snowboarding.
