
JOCKVALE'S FRIDAY MESSAGE - OCT. 6th, 2023



BUS LOOP - Drivers are asked to avoid using the bus loop in front of the school during bus arrival and departure times. The signs with the times are posted outside. We are thankful to have buses, but several routes are regularly late. Therefore, the bus loop must be clear of parent/guardian vehicles during the posted hours.
