
Please note that we will not make phone calls home at the office about forgotten loonies and toonies on Fridays, so it's best to prepare in advance.


- Wed June 5th- Pink, Red, White and Purple

Jockvale now uses the <u>Safe Arrival System</u> which is an automated attendance program. The Safe Arrival System has replaced some of our current attendance routines, like the Google form and phone calls. The system contacts families for unreported absences. Please download the app if you haven't done so already thanks!



TICK SAFETY - We have had a report of a student who may have gotten a tick in the yard. At Jockvale, we have requested that the lawns be kept as short as possible, and we will discuss tick checks with students.

Ticks are prevalent throughout Ontario and ticks "are related to spiders, so they have eight legs. They have flat, oval bodies that swell when they eat. And they feed on the blood of all kinds of animals, from birds to deer to humans. They're also very small. Even adult ticks are only about the size of an apple seed unless they've just fed. That means they're hard to
