
### **JOCKVALE'S FRIDAY MESSAGE - SEPT. 13th, 2024**

## **HEALTH & SAFETY @ JOCKVALE -**



### 1. Anaphylaxis Awareness

Please be aware that some of our students and staff have severe and potentially life-threatening allergies to certain food products, especially peanuts and other nuts. Anaphylaxis is an emergency medical condition that can result in death. While it is impossible to create a risk-free environment, we can take important steps to minimize potentially fatal allergic reactions. In a spirit of caring and to ensure consistency at Jockvale, nuts and peanuts should not be brought to school. This includes products that may contain nuts and peanuts.

If your Jockvale student has anaphylaxis, or any other life-threatening condition, families are asked to complete a Plan of Care. Please contact the school office (613-825-1224) if you have questions about Plans of Care.

- 2. <u>Emergency Procedures</u> At Jockvale, we actively prepare to follow our emergency procedures by conducting drills and having age-appropriate classroom and school discussions. In the next few weeks we will be conducting three fire drills and a lockdown drill. The school will send out a specific message about the lockdown drill in advance.
- 3. <u>Update Your Contact Information</u> Emergency Contact Forms were sent home this week. Thank you for returning this form promptly as we rely on the information to communicate with parents, guardians, and caregivers. We call home for many reasons, ranging from a forgotten lunch to a medical concern, and up to date contact information is essential to the health and safety of our students.

Please note that the school will <u>not</u> contact parents/guardians via Facebook or Instagram accounts or any other social media account.

4. <u>Be Prepared for the Outdoors</u> - In case of an emergency, sometimes students may need to spend extra time outdoors. Please ensure that students are dressed appropriately for the weather because a medical emergency, a fire drill, or a school evacuation may result in spending extended time outside the building.

Students must have **indoor shoes** and wear them in the school building at all times. This is to protect their feet indoors and to ensure a quick and safe exit during a fire drill, medical emergency, or evacuation.

PHONE POLICY FOR STUDENTS @ JOCKVALE (Personal Mobile Device (PMD) Policy) -

We recommend that students NOT bring PMDs to school. Personal mobile device (PMD) refers to any personal electronic device that can be used to communicate or access the internet, such as a cell phone, tablet, laptop, earbuds, Smartwatch, etc.

If your child requires a PMD for communication with you, the expectations are listed below. These expectations apply to the school property and the school bus:

JK - Gr 6: Students in these grades will need to keep personal mobile devices on silent and out of sight for the entire school day, unless explicitly permitted by the student's educator.

If a student in JK - 6 does not follow the direction, the student must hand in their device for the instructional day and the device must be placed, by the student, in a storage area in a location designated by the educator. Educators will follow OCDSB School District Code of Conduct P.125.SCO and Progressive Discipline and Promoting Positive Student Behaviour PR.660.SCO when working through situations where students are not adhering to the expectations.

Please note that exceptions will be made for students with life-threatening conditions whose PMD is part of their Plan of Care (i.e., a child with Diabetes whose pump is connected via app).

Video game units (i.e., Nintendo Switch) must remain at home to avoid distraction and potential damage.

Laptops - With the permission of educators and parents/guardians, junior students (grade 4 to 6) may bring a laptop to school for educational purposes. However, junior classes have access to classroom Chromebooks.

Please note that neither the District nor the school is responsible for students' personal tech from home should anything happen to them.
